26/14. Apologies for absence- none

27/14. Public Participation – Jane Somper provided a District report which included the final recommendations for the Boundary Commission new plan. A new Waste Partnership doorstep survey is being carried out over 3 months to deal with customer satisfaction and queries.

A member of the public asked if anything could be done in Chescombe Lane Whatcombe Lane and Rook Lane with the Community SpeedWatch due to the speeding traffic there as well as main A354. DB replied by saying that we are unable to carry out any Community Speed watch in these lanes due to health and safety. The police can though and DB will ask SNT if they could assist. It was mentioned that another village has small roadside signs to try and slow the traffic. It was believed that a local school there had made the signs and it was suggested that WW look into this idea. The clerk to contact the local clerk in that village to find out more. It was mentioned that No Excuses sign already at start of village in Chescombe Lane Michael Rea from Clenston Estates provided a short update on the problems with the allotments and fly tipping on the land by them. The PC confirmed that they have asked Spectrum to contact their local tenants about the problem. He said that they will be reviewing the way the allotments are being used currently. He also mentioned that there is no further action on the phase 2 of Fosters Meadows at present.

28/14. Approval of Minutes-

The Minutes of the meeting held on 5th March 2014 had been previously circulated and were now approved and duly signed.

29/14. Matters Arising-

Speeding Traffic. DB advised that 14 more vehicles had been reported to the police by the Community Speed Watch team last month. He also mentioned that he had received details from local a resident about a van speeding through the village without lights on during fog which was passed to the police. The police do follow up on these details.

It was agreed to place the original No Excuses Sign out in Chescombe Lane for a period before moving it one of the other lanes..

30/14 Lady Bailey Bus Shelter- An alternative suggestion by AT to re-clad it in marine ply instead of replacing it. DB/Clerk to check on costs.

The Notice board has been ordered and waiting on confirmation of a delivery date.

A proposal was then made to defer the shelter although it was agreed that an allowance of £200 to re-clad it was made. Proposed AT 2nd EP -Carried

Priority to be given to the Play Park
