20/13. Apologies for absence- Emma Parker

21/13. District Report –Jane Somper advised that North Dorset District Council have agreed to freeze the level of Council Tax giving a net budget for 2015/16 of £5,563,750, representing a Council Tax at Band D of £111.96 per annum. It was also confirmed that the new CEO of the Tri Council Partnership will be Matt Prosser
A report from Emma Parker was read in her absence regarding a discussion with NDDC Licensing Officer on the Lady Bailey issues: The dates given for works/quotes to be received from Mr Penfold to the licensing officer were dates that Mr Penfold suggested and not Mr Davis they were:

The water piping to be replaced by 27th March 2015.

Final quotation for electrical works to be submitted by 8th May 2015

Works on the underground electric supply to start no later than 1st September.

Sewer works to be undertaken by end of March 2016.

Also if Lady Bailey was to be an ongoing agenda item then to give Mr Penfold notice of the meeting so he could attend if he wanted to add anything or send a report.

23/13. Approval of Minutes- The Minutes of the meeting held on 4th February 2015 had been previously circulated and were now approved and duly signed.

24/13. Matters Arising-

Speedwatch-AT advised that they have been out 4 times since the last meeting and a new member will be joining the team shortly.

The new PC web site should be up and running soon.

The crown lift of the tree in the Play Park should be done soon –currently waiting on further quotes having received one quote for £250 to £300 to crown lift tree and still waiting for more. It was agreed to ask Charles Lovell for a quote.

The damage to the grass in Fields Close- The Clerk has finally had a meeting with Spectrum and they have agreed to level and sort the damaged area out hopefully very shortly.

The update on the late arrival of the 183 bus recently – Damory have advised that unfortunately this is beyond their control and due to road problems along the route. Regarding the last time of the weekday bus from Blandford they are unable to alter this as timetable agreed with DCC who have not as yet responded to the PC on this issue.

Lady Bailey issues with water and electricity supply –both, the water company and electricity company are unable to assist as only able to deal with their customer and not the actual consumer. See also EP's report regarding discussion with NDDC licensing officer.

The pot holes in Dolway lane have been partially repaired.
