

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WEST STREET & LOWER STREET, WINTERBORNE STICKLAND

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along West Street, Winterborne Kingston from outside West Down Barn, West Street and Sunnyside Farm, Lower Street (in both directions), a distance of approximately 840 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 24th February 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5th March 2025.

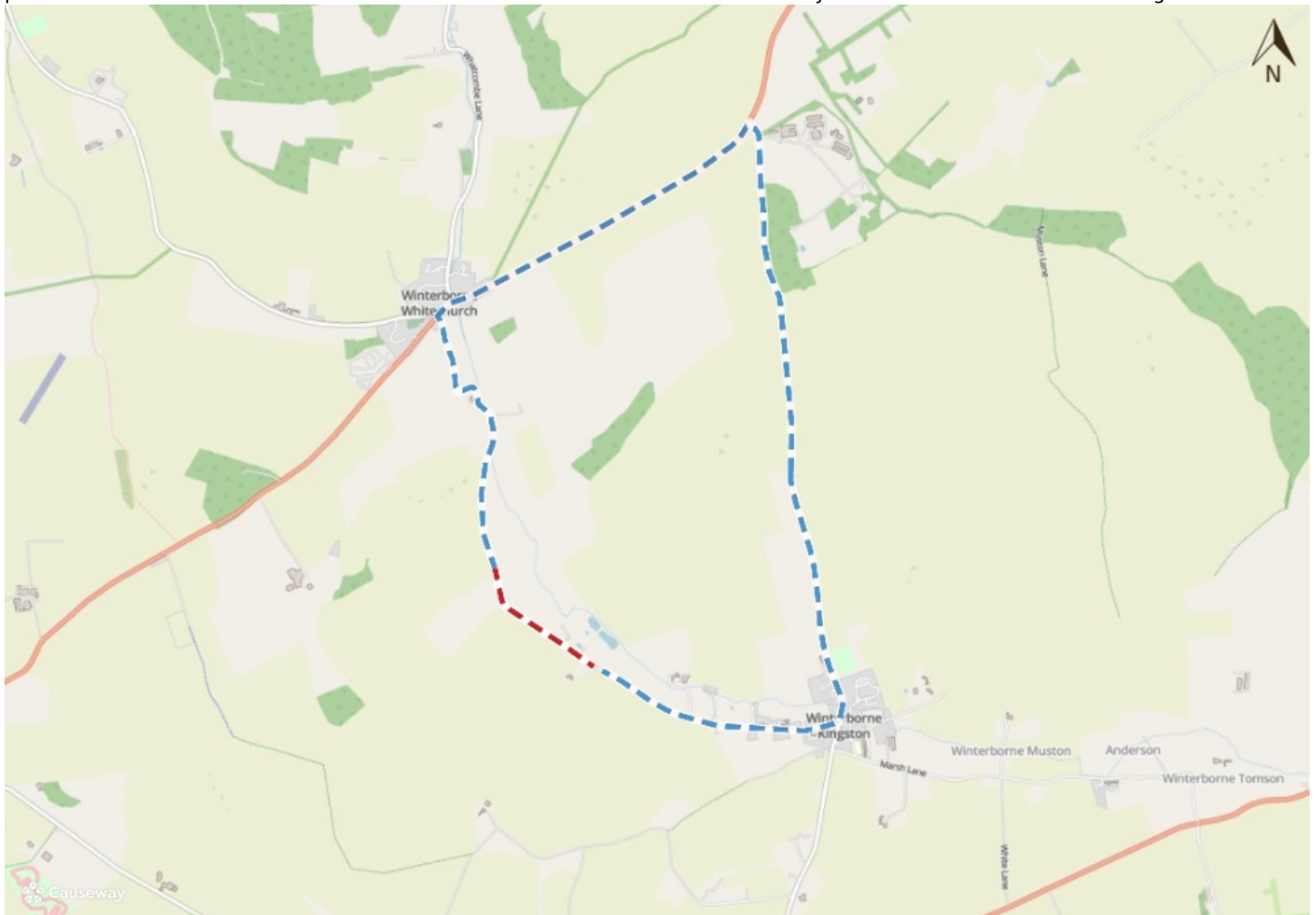
**This Order will provide Openreach engineers with a safe working area to lay ducting.**
